The Campaign Cabinet is responsible for the review of all naming requests prior to discussion with prospective donors or honorees.

Named Buildings, Rooms & Spaces

Donors to the Capital Campaign that make significant gifts will be recognized with naming opportunities on the building, rooms, spaces and gathering spaces both indoor and outdoor

Plaques & Identifications Markers

Donors to the capital campaign that make gifts between \$10,000 and \$100,000 will be recognized with either a plaque or identification marker that recognizes the contributor on the wall near the room or space.

Donor Wall

All donors to the capital campaign will be acknowledged with a written letter of appreciation, have their names listed in publications and be recognized in a permanent manner on the donor wall at the Nature center.

To acknowledge special contributions to the campaign, names of all donors will be listed in campaign publications and website unless anonymity is requested.

In addition to our deep appreciation, generous gifts of \$10,000 or more are recognized and celebrated.

Campaign staff and volunteer leadership can assist you in determining this lasting remembrance. Pledges are payable over a 5-year period. Recognitions are made upon receipt of pledges.

Governance of Naming & Recognition

This document governs the naming of the Nature Center entities and physical spaces at the New Nature Center.

Recommended funding levels and proposed names for buildings, physical facilities or spaces must be reviewed by the Board President prior to the Board of Directors approval. Friends of Willow River & Kinnickinnic State Parks must give final approval for all naming's.

If, at any time, circumstances change such that the continued use of an approved name may compromise the Friends of Willow River & Kinnickinnic State Parks integrity or reputation, the Board of Friends of Willow River & Kinnickinnic State Parks may amend or remove the name
